Apple Varieties

Semi Dwarf: (12'-15' Tall and Wide)

‘Golden Delicious’

Z. 4-9

Very sweet, mid-season variety.
Ripens in September.
No pollinator needed.



‘Gala’

Z. 4-9

Sweet-tart flavor. Ripens in Oct.
No pollinator needed.



‘Mcintosh’

Z. 4-8

Cold hardy. Crisp and a sweet-tart flavor.
Ripens in August. Pollinator needed:
Gala.



‘Fuji’

Z. 4-9

Sweet, crisp, flavorful. No pollinator
needed. Ripens in September. Self-fertile,
but an Excellent pollinator for other
varieties.



‘Mutsu Crispin’

Z. 4-8

Very large, crisp fruit. Harvest when green or allow to ripen to yellow. Fully ripens in October. Powdery mildew resistant. Pollinated by Fuji or Gala



Columnar: (10’ Tall by 2’ Wide)

‘Northpole’

Z. 4-8

Large, red skinned apples, similar to McIntosh. Juicy, crisp and aromatic. Ripens in August. Narrow, growing, columnar habit. Pollinated by ‘Scarlet Sentinel’ or another ‘Northpole’.



‘Scarlet Sentinel’

Z. 4-8

Large, greenish-yellow fruit with a red blush. Ripens in September. Narrow, growing, columnar habit. Adapts well to container growing. Pollinated by ‘Northpole’ or another ‘Scarlet Sentinel’.
